COURSE: Incident Management System (IMS) 100 - Introduction to Incident Management System

This introductory course will prepare you to work within the Incident Management System in Ontario. This course is designed to teach you the basic functions, concepts and principles of the Incident Management System (IMS).

At the end of this course you will be aware of the major functions within IMS, and be able to assume limited roles within an incident management team for simple incidents.

- Estimated time of completion: 4 hours

Access and Completion

1. Go to https://training.emergencymanagementontario.ca/TPOnline/TPOnline.dll/EMO_Login
2. Check that pop-ups are not blocked for this site.
3. Create a new user and select the following for your organization:
Group: First Nations
Organization: Nishnawbe-Aski Nation (NAN)
4. Confirmation email from OFMEM will be sent. Please check the junk folder if the email is not seen after 10 minutes.
5. Follow link in email and login as per email instructions.
6. Select "Course Catalogue" once logged into account.
7. Select IMS 100: Introduction to Incident Management System.
8. Download self study package: IMS-100 course reading package (PDF version).
9. Complete readings.
10. When ready, select "Enrol to take the exam".
11. Select "Enrol in Course" at bottom of page.
12. Select "IMS 100 Final Exam".
13. A secondary window will open with the exam. If it does not open, check the blocked pop-ups.
14. Complete exam.
15. Save certificate of completion as a pdf.
16. Email certificate to emergency@nan.ca
